7AM to 6PM (Stirickly enforced)

Late pick-up fee of \$2.00 per minute after 6:00pm. Must be paid at the time of pick-up (STRICTLY ENFORCED)

ONLINE THROUGH YOUR ACCOUNT LOGIN, AT TIME OF REGISTRATION

- Cash payment is the only form of payment accepted on-site prior to week attending.
- Any outstanding balances (including all prior reserved weeks) must be paid before a camper can return to camp.
- Credits will not be issued for missed days or improper cancellation.

Change or Cancellations: **MUST** be made BY 6 PM MONDAY December 28, 2020.

- 1 week prior to the reserved week attending.
- Reserved week cancellations made within the above advised guidelines will be refunded minus the \$5.00 deposit and the 3% processing fee.

Refunds:

- Refunds will only be issued with proper cancellation protocol minus \$5 deposit plus the 3% processing fee.
- Transfer of funds to different weeks with proper change protocol will result in a 3% processing fee (The \$5.00 deposit will apply to transfer).

Return Check Fee:

• All online returned checks will have a \$25.00 fee and must be handled immediately on-site.

Staffing:

- Our highly trained staff consists of certified teachers, college and high school individuals.
- CPR, and First aid trained.

Staff/Child Ratio:

• 1:20 (1 staff member to every 20 campers)

Drop off & Pick-up procedures:

Arrival & Departure

- **All campers** must be escorted into Hot Wheels, signed in by an authorized person and remain until released to a staff member.
- **All campers** must be signed out by an authorized person and remain until released to their parent/legal guardian.
- **Health Screening**: Temperatures will be taken upon entering the building. Any temperature 100.4 or higher will not be allowed to participate in the daily camp.
- **Symptomatic Exclusion**: Anyone with a fever, couch, sore throat or flu like symptoms will not be permitted to remain onsite

Parking:

- Please park in designated parking spaces ONLY.
- NOT IN FRONT OF THE BUILDING OR GRASS.

Lunch:

Brown bag and water bottle from home daily (no refrigerator or microwave available for students)

2 snacks are provided by Hot Wheels daily
